Response to the proposed closure of Wells Road, Fakenham Post Office

I strongly disagree with the proposal to close Wells Road Post Office in Fakenham, on the following grounds:

1. Fakenham has a population of 8000 and growing, and this would leave the town with only one post office which would cause problems of queues and delays.
2. The surrounding villages North of Fakenham will have very difficult access to a post office.
3. Wells Road post office has good customer car parking, which is very convenient for the elderly and disabled.
4. There is proposed expansion of housing this side of the town, which will increase usage.
5. The surviving town centre post office is in a small confined area and already experiences queues.
6. Leaving only one post office will mean increased traffic in the town as customers from the North side will have no choice but to go into Fakenham Town Centre.
